The incumbent will provide direction and coordination of the overall affairs of the ACIHA in accordance with the policies of the ACIHA Board of Commissioners (BOC) in order to develop and operate a sufficient quantity of decent, safe, and sanitary homes and to provide employment opportunities for low income families living within the ACIHA's area of operations.
